

Things to do in Walhalla....

Thanks for your enquiry about Walhalla – a truly beautiful and historic part of Gippsland.

Please find below some information that may be useful when planning your visit.



Take a trip on the spectacular Walhalla Goldfields railway. This scenic train trip operates from Walhalla to Thomson Station every weekend, public holiday and Wednesday. www.walhallarail.com.au or phone 5165-6280



Visit the Long Tunnel Extended (Tourist) Gold mine. This mine was one of the towns richest and returned over 17T of gold. Tours daily. www.walhallaboard.org.au or phone 5165-6259



Visit the Walhalla Museum and experience the history of one of Victoria's richest gold towns. Open every day 10.00AM-4.00PM.

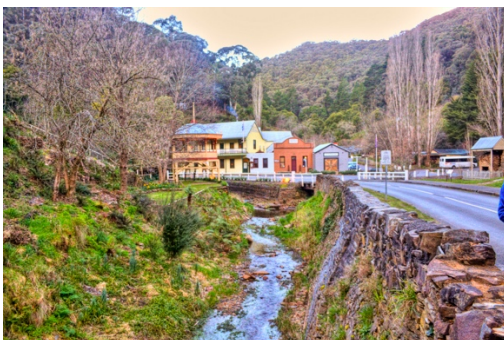


Do a Walhalla Ghost Tour to experience Walhalla's darker and stranger side. Tours operate every Saturday night. Booking essential. Phone 5165-6250

Walk around the town and follow the extensive trail of interpretive signs that make up the “Walhalla Heritage Walk.”



- Fish for trout in the Thomson river. The river is also a great place to escape the heat during summer.
- Explore some of the 4x4 tracks around the town. Bring your own 4x4 or mountain bike!
- Dine in one of the towns eateries or cafes.
- Enjoy a “Chicken Walhalla” and a drink at the Walhalla Hotel.
- Stay in one of our very classy B&Bs.



- Climb to Walhalla’s historic Cricket Ground - one of Australia’s most unusual. It is situated on the top of a mountain overlooking the town.
- Pan for gold in Stringers Creek, which runs through the centre of town. (Gold pans can be hired at the museum.)
- Laze under a tree.
- Walk the tramway, from the steps opposite the Mechanics Institute, to the North Gardens.
- Feeling like a longer walk, you can take the tramway along back out of town towards ‘Poverty Point Bridge’ it will take about 4 hours return. Or get the train back from Thomson station.
- Visit one of our many shops.
- Enjoy a picnic in Stringers Park. Free gas BBQ’s provided.
- Get some extraordinary photographs to upload on Facebook. *(But remember at this stage there is no mobile phone coverage in Walhalla.)*
